

Fabric Needed

3 Wishes Fabric® Spooky Night Collection by Beth Albert

- 1 ¼ yards Patchwork (18111-MLT-CTN-D)
- 1 yard Black Solid
- 3/4 yard Webs (18112-CHR-CTN-D)
- ³/₄ yard Forest (18114-PUR-CTN-D)
- ³/₄ yard Pumpkin Patch (18115-GRY-CTN-D)
- ¹/₃ yard Jack (18113-BLK-CTN-D)
- 2 ¾ yards Webs (18112-CHR-CTN-D) for Backing (Directional)

Additional Supplies Needed:

- 61" x 61" (154.94 cm x 154.94 cm) Cotton batting
- 16 9" (22.86 cm) Paper plates
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6.35 mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

Cutting


Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below. Refer to Diagrams A-H to label the paper plates with the Block identification and organize the pieces for each block on the plates as they are cut.





Sewing


Note: Fabric is directional. Label Blocks as they are made.

Place one Pumpkin Patch vertical rectangle 5" x 12 ½" (12.7 cm x 31.75 cm), one Fussy Cut Patchwork vertical rectangle 6 ½" x 7 ½" (16.51 cm x 19.05 cm), one Jack rectangle 4" x 6 ½" (10.16 cm x 16.51 cm), one Black Solid rectangle 2" x 12 ½" (5.08 cm x 31.75 cm) and one Black Solid rectangle 2" x 6 ½" (5.08 cm x 16.51 cm) as shown in Diagram A. Pin the pieces in Column 3 RST, sew and press. Pin the Columns together, sew and press to make Block 1A finishing at 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75 cm x 31.75 cm).



2. Follow Step 1 and Diagram B using three Pumpkin Patch vertical rectangles 5" x 12 ½" (12.7 cm x 31.75 cm), three Fussy Cut Patchwork vertical rectangles 6 ½" x 7 ½" (16.51 cm x 19.05 cm), three Jack rectangles 4" x 6 ½" (10.16 cm x 16.51 cm), three Black Solid rectangles 2" x 12 ½" (5.08 cm x 31.75 cm) and three Black Solid rectangles 2" x 6 ½" (5.08 cm x 16.51 cm) to make Blocks 1C, 3A and 3C each finishing at 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75 cm x 31.75 cm).



3. Place one Forest vertical rectangle 5" x 12 ½" (12.7 cm x 31.75 cm), one Fussy Cut Patchwork vertical rectangle 6 ½" x 7 ½" (16.51 cm x 19.05 cm), one Jack rectangle 4" x 6 ½" (10.16 cm x 16.51 cm), one Black Solid rectangle 2" x 12 ½" (5.08 cm x 31.75 cm) and one Black Solid rectangle 2" x 6 ½" (5.08 cm x 16.51 cm) as shown in Diagram C. Pin the pieces in Column 1 RST, sew and press. Pin the Columns together, sew and press to make Block 1B finishing at 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75 cm x 31.75 cm).



4. Follow Step 3 and Diagram D using three Forest vertical rectangles 5" x 12 ½" (12.7 cm x 31.75 cm), three Fussy Cut Patchwork vertical rectangles 6 ½" x 7 ½" (16.51 cm x 19.05 cm), three Jack rectangles 4" x 6 ½" (10.16 cm x 16.51 cm), three Black Solid rectangles 2" x 12 ½" (5.08 cm x 31.75 cm) and three Black Solid rectangles 2" x 6 ½" (5.08 cm x 16.51 cm) to make Blocks 1D, 3B and 3D each finishing at 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75 cm x 31.75 cm).










5. Place one Forest horizontal rectangle 12 ½" x 5 ½" (31.75 cm x 12.7 cm), one Fussy Cut Patchwork horizontal rectangle 7 ½" x 6 ½" (19.05 cm x 16.51 cm), one Webs rectangle 4" x 6 ½" (10.16 cm x 16.51 cm), one Black Solid rectangle 2" x 12 ½" (5.08 cm x 31.75 cm) and one Black Solid rectangle 2" x 6 ½" (5.08 cm x 16.51 cm) as shown in Diagram E. Pin the pieces in Row 1 RST, sew and press. Pin the Rows together, sew and press to make Block 2A finishing at 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75 cm x 31.75 cm).



6. Follow Step 5 and Diagram F using three Forest horizontal rectangles 12 ½" x 5 ½" (31.75 cm x 12.7 cm), three Fussy Cut Patchwork horizontal rectangles 7 ½" x 6 ½" (19.05 cm x 16.51 cm), three Webs rectangles 4" x 6 ½" (10.16 cm x 16.51 cm), three Black Solid rectangles 4" x 6 ½" (10.16 cm x 16.51 cm) and three Black Solid rectangles 2" x 6 ½" (5.08 cm x 16.51 cm) to make Blocks 2C, 4A and 4C each finishing at 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75 cm x 31.75 cm).




Place one Pumpkin Patch horizontal rectangle 12 ½" x 5 ½" (31.75 cm x 12.7cm), one Fussy Cut Patchwork horizontal rectangle 7 ½" x 6 ½" (19.05 cm x 16.51 cm), one Webs rectangle 4" x 6 ½" (10.16 cm x 16.51 cm), one Black Solid rectangle 4" x 6 ½" (10.16 cm x 16.51 cm) and one Black Solid rectangle 2" x 6 ½" (5.08 cm x 16.51 cm) as shown in Diagram G. Pin the pieces in Row 3 RST, sew and press. Pin the Rows together, sew and press to make Block 2B finishing at 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75 cm x 31.75 cm).




8. Follow Step 7 and Diagram H using three Pumpkin Patch horizontal rectangles 12 ½" x 5 ½" (31.75 cm x 12.7 cm), three Fussy Cut Patchwork horizontal rectangles 7 ½" x 6 ½" (19.05 cm x 16.51 cm), three Web rectangles 4" x 6 ½" (10.16 cm x 16.51 cm), three Black Solid rectangles 4" x 6 ½" (10.16 cm x 16.51 cm) and three Black Solid rectangles 2" x 6 ½" (5.08 cm x 16.51 cm) to make Blocks 2D, 4B and 4D finishing at 12 ½" x 12 ½" (31.75 cm x 31.75 cm).



9. Place four Black Solid strips 2" x 12 ¹/₂" (5.08 cm x 31.75 cm) and three Jack squares 2" x 2" (5.08 cm x 5.08 cm) as shown in Diagram I. Pin RST, sew and press to make Row 2 finishing at 2" x 53" (5.08 cm x 134.62 cm). Repeat to make Rows 4 and 6.




10. Place Blocks 1A, 1B, 1C and 1D and three Black Solid rectangles 2" x 12 ½" (5.08 cm x 31.75 cm) as shown in Diagram J. Pin RST, sew and press to make Row 1 finishing at 12 ½" x 53" (31.75 cm x 134.62 cm). Pin a label with the Row number on the first block.

11. Follow Step 10 and Diagram K using Blocks 2A, 2B, 2C and 2D and three Black Solid rectangles 2" x 12 ¹/₂" (5.08 cm x 31.75 cm) to make Row 3 finishing at 12 ¹/₂" x 53" (31.75 cm x 134.62 cm).

12. Follow Step 10 and Diagram L using Blocks 3A, 3B, 3C and 3D 2" x 12 1/2" (5.08 cm x 31.75 cm) to make Row 5 finishing at 12 1/2" x 53" (31.75 cm x 134.62 cm).



13. Follow Step 10 and Diagram M using Blocks 4A, 4B, 4C and 4D 2" x 12 1/2" (5.08 cm x 31.75 cm) to make Row 7 finishing at 12 1/2" x 53" (31.75 cm x 134.62 cm).




14. Place Rows 1-7 as shown in Diagram N, matching ends and seams. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Spooky Night Quilt Top finishing at 53" x 53" (134.62 cm x 134.62 cm).



## Finishing

12. Remove the selvages from the Webs Backing fabric. *Note:* Check the direction of the printed design. Cut one piece 40 ¼" x 61" (102.24 cm x 154.94 cm) and two pieces 21 ¼" x 30 ¾" (53.98 cm x 78.12 cm). Pin RST and sew the two smaller pieces on the short edges; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew along the long edges as shown in Diagram O. Press the seam open or to one side. The Backing should measure 61" x 61" (154.94 cm x 154.94 cm).



- 13. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, **wrong** side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
- 14. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
- 15. Binding Follow Diagram P to make the Webs Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the six 2 ½" (6.35 cm) x wof strips RST end to end at a 45° angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼" (6.35mm) to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2" (5.08 cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.



### Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. **Tip:** Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
