BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY


Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Place (1) **B** 3-1/2" square on the left side of (1) **D** $3-1/2" \ge 6-1/2"$ strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}"$ seam allowance.




2. Place another **B** 3-1/2" square on the right side of the **D** $3-1/2" \ge 6-1/2"$ strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}"$ seam allowance to make (1) **Unit 1** strip.

3. Repeat **Steps 1-2** to make (24) **Unit 1** strips total.




4. Sew (1) **C** 3-1/2" square to each end of (1) **Unit 1** strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) **Unit 1** strip to each side of

(1) **A** 6-1/2" square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) **Block One** square. Repeat to make (6) **Block One** squares total.




5. Sew (1) **F** 2" x WOF strip to each side of (1) **D** 3-1/2" x WOF strip lengthwise to make (1) **Strip Set 1**. Repeat to make a second **Strip Set 1**.

6. Cut the (2) Strip Set 1's into (24) 2" x 6-1/2" Unit 2 strips.




7. Sew (1) **D** 2" x WOF strip to each side of (1) **G** 3-1/2" x WOF strip lengthwise to make (1) **Strip Set 2**. Repeat to make a second **Strip Set 2**.



9. Sew (1) **Unit 3** strip to the top of (1) **Unit 2** strip lengthwise to make (1) **Unit 4** strip. Repeat to make (24) **Unit 4** strips total.



10. Place (1) **D** 2" square on the top left corner of (1) **E** 6-1/2" square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.




11. Follow diagram below for the seam direction to add a **D** 2" square to each of the remaining corners of the **E** 6-1/2" square to make (1) **Unit 5** square.

12. Repeat **Steps 10-11** to make (6) **Unit 5** squares total.



13. Sew (1) **H** 3-1/2" square to each end of (1) **Unit 4** strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew

(1) Unit 4 strip to
each side of (1) Unit 5
square to make the
middle row. Sew the
(3) rows together
lengthwise to make
(1) Block Two square.
Repeat to make (6)
Block Two squares
total.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

14. Sew (1) **Block One** square to each side of (1) **Block Two** square to make **Row One**. Repeat to make **Row Three**.

15. Sew (1) **Block Two** square to each side of (1) **Block One** square to make **Row Two**. Repeat to make **Row Four**.

16. Sew the (4) **Rows** together, in numerical order, to make the **Center Block**.

BORDER ASSEMBLY *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE I AND J BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*


17. Sew (1) I 2" x 48-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) I 2" x 39-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

18. Sew (1) **J** $4-1/2^{"} \ge 51-1/2^{"}$ strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **J** $4-1/2^{"} \ge 47-1/2^{"}$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

QUILT DIAGRAM

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 47" x 59"
