Finished Size: 54 ½ in x 56 ½ in (138.43 cm x 143.51 cm)

Fabric Needed

- 3 Wishes Fabric® Touch of Spring Collection**
- 1 Panel – Dwelling Panel (18751-PNL-CTN-D)
 - 2 yds – Shelves (18748-BLU-CTN-D)
 - ¾ yd – Floral (18749-MLT-CTN-D) for Piecing and Binding
 - ½ yd – Bunnies (18746-PNK-CTN-D)
 - ¾ yd – Bird Houses (18745-BLU-CTN-D)
 - 2 ¾ yds – Wagoneer (18747-WHT-CTN-D) for Backing

- 3 Wishes Fabric® Good Vibes Collection**
- ½ yd – Circle Dots (18660-WOW-CTN-D)

Additional Supplies Needed:

- 63 in x 63 in Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a ¼ in (6.35 mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric


Note: A printed panel may become slightly skewed during the finishing process. Check if panel is square before cutting by folding the panel so selvages meet. If all edges do not meet, pull firmly from corner to corner until the edges meet. Continue until all corners are square.

Cutting


Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.



Dwelling Panel – 18751-PNL-CTN-D (36 in x wof / 91.44 cm x 106.68 cm)
Fussy Cut 1 – 32 ½ in x 36 ½ in (82.55 cm x 90.17 cm)




Floral – 18749-MLT-CTN-D (¾ yd x wof / 68.58 cm x 106.68 cm)
Cut 6 – 2 ½ in x wof (6.35 cm x 106.68 cm) for Binding
Cut 12 – 4 ½ in x 4 ½ in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm)




Bunnies – 18746-PNK-CTN-D (½ yd x wof / 45.72 cm x 106.68 cm)
Cut 4 – 2 in x 24 ½ in (5.08 cm x 62.23 cm)
Cut 4 – 1 ½ in x 22 in (3.81 cm x 55.88 cm)



Shelves – 18748-BLU-CTN-D (2 yds x wof / 182.88 cm x 106.68 cm)
Fussy Cut 4 – 4 ½ in x 28 ½ in (11.43 cm x 72.39 cm)
Fussy Cut 4 – 4 ½ in x 23 ½ in (11.43 cm x 59.69 cm)



Circle Dots – 18660-WOW-CTN-D (½ yd x wof / 45.72 cm x 106.68 cm)

 Cut 2 – 2 in x 38 ½ in (5.08 cm x 97.79 cm)
 Cut 2 – 1 ½ in x 32 ½ in (3.81 cm x 82.55 cm)
 Cut 6 – 1 ½ in x 10 ½ in (3.81 cm x 26.67 cm)
 Cut 6 – 1 ½ in x 9 ½ in (3.81 cm x 24.13 cm)




Bird Houses – 18745-BLU-CTN-D (¾ yd x wof / 34.29 cm x 106.68 cm)
 Cut 6 – 3 ½ in x 10 ½ in (8.89 cm x 26.67 cm)
 Cut 6 – 3 ½ in x 9 ½ in (8.89 cm x 24.13 cm)

Sewing

- Place a Circle Dots strip 1 ½ in x 32 ½ in (3.81 cm x 82.55 cm) on each side of the Fussy Cut Dwelling Panel rectangle 32 ½ in x 36 ½ in (82.55 cm x 92.17 cm). Pin RST matching ends and centers, sew and press. Place a Circle Dots strip 2 in x 38 ½ in (5.08 cm x 97.79 cm) on the top and bottom. Pin RST matching ends and centers, sew and press. The Quilt Center should measure 35 ½ in x 38 ½ in (90.17 cm x 97.79 cm).



- Place a Circle Dots strip 1 ½ in x 9 ½ in (3.81 cm x 24.13 cm) and a vertical Bird Houses rectangle 3 ½ in x 9 ½ in (8.89 cm x 24.13 cm) oriented as shown in Diagram B. Pin RST, sew and press to make a Left Side Border Unit 4 ½ in x 9 ½ in (11.43 cm x 24.13 cm). Repeat to make three.



3. Follow Step 2 and Diagram C using three Circle Dots strips 1 ½ in x 9 ½ in (3.81 cm x 24.13 cm) and three Vertical Bird Houses rectangles 3 ½ in x 9 ½ in (8.89 cm x 24.13 cm) oriented as shown to make three Right Side Border Units 4 ½ in x 9 ½ in (11.43 cm x 24.13 cm).

4. Follow Step 2 and Diagram D using three Circle Dots strips 1 ½ in x 10 ½ in (3.81 cm x 26.67 cm) and three horizontal Bird Houses rectangles 3 ½ in x 10 ½ in (8.89 cm x 26.67 cm) oriented as shown to make three Top Border Units 4 ½ in x 10 ½ in (11.43 cm x 26.67 cm).

5. Follow Step 2 and Diagram E using three Circle Dots strips 1 ½ in x 10 ½ in (3.81 cm x 26.67 cm) and three horizontal Bird Houses rectangles 3 ½ in x 10 ½ in (8.89 cm x 26.67 cm) oriented as shown to make three Bottom Border Units 4 ½ in x 10 ½ in (11.43 cm x 26.67 cm).




6. Alternate two Floral squares 4 ½ in x 4 ½ in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) with the three Left Side Border Units 4 ½ in x 9 ½ in (11.43 cm x 24.13 cm) oriented as shown in Diagram F. Pin RST, sew and press (toward the Floral squares) to make the Bird Houses Left Side Border 4 ½ in x 35 ½ in (11.43 cm x 90.17 cm).


7. Follow Step 6 and Diagram G using two Floral squares 4 ½ in x 4 ½ in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) with the three Right Side Border Units 4 ½ in x 9 ½ in (11.43 cm x 24.13 cm) oriented as shown to make the Bird Houses Right Side Border 4 ½ in x 35 ½ in (11.43 cm x 90.17 cm).


8. Follow Step 6 and Diagram H using four Floral squares 4 ½ in x 4 ½ in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) with the three Top Border Units 4 ½ in x 10 ½ in (11.43 cm x 26.67 cm) oriented as shown to make the Bird Houses Top Border 4 ½ in x 46 ½ in (11.43 cm x 118.11 cm).


9. Follow Step 6 and Diagram I using four Floral squares 4 ½ in x 4 ½ in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) with the three Bottom Border Units 4 ½ in x 10 ½ in (11.43 cm x 26.67 cm) oriented as shown to make the Bird Houses Bottom Border 4 ½ in x 46 ½ in (11.43 cm x 118.11 cm).

10. Place two Bunnies strips 1 ½ in x 22 in (3.81 cm x 55.88 cm) as shown in Diagram J. Pin RST, sew and press open or to one side to make the Bunnies Side Border 1 ½ in x 43 ½ in (3.81 cm x 110.49 cm). Repeat to make two. **Note:** Check orientation of design.

11. Follow Step 10 and Diagram K using four Bunnies strips 2 in x 24 ½ in (5.08 cm x 62.23 cm) to make the Bunnies Top and Bottom Borders 2 in x 48 ½ in (5.08 cm x 123.19 cm).


12. Follow Step 10 and Diagram L using four Fussy Cut Shelves rectangles 4 ½ in x 23 ½ in (11.43 cm x 59.69 cm) matching fabric print at the center seam to make two Shelves Side Borders 4 ½ in x 46 ½ in (11.43 cm x 118.11 cm). **Note:** Check orientation of design.

13. Follow Step 10 and Diagram M using four Fussy Cut Shelves rectangles 4 ½ in x 28 ½ in (11.43 cm x 72.39 cm) to make the Shelves Top and Bottom Borders 4 ½ in x 46 ½ in (11.43 cm x 143.51 cm).

14. Refer to Diagram N to place the Borders around the Quilt Center $35\frac{1}{2}$ in x $38\frac{1}{2}$ in (90.17 cm x 97.79 cm). **Note:** Check orientation of design. Pin matching center, seams and ends. Sew each Border RST in the order listed. Press seams as shown. Measure at each step to ensure the next border will fit. **Tip:** If one border is a little larger than the border it is being sewn to, pin well to ease the fullness and place the fullness on the bottom while sewing.

Finished Quilt Top should measure $54\frac{1}{2}$ in x $56\frac{1}{2}$ in (138.43 cm x 143.51 cm).

Bird Houses Border

Sides: 2 – Left and Right Side Borders $4\frac{1}{2}$ in x $35\frac{1}{2}$ in (11.43 cm x 90.17 cm); made in Steps 6 and 7
 Top and Bottom: Top and Bottom Borders $4\frac{1}{2}$ in x $46\frac{1}{2}$ in (11.43 cm x 118.11 cm); made in Steps 8 and 9
 Quilt Top - $43\frac{1}{2}$ in x $46\frac{1}{2}$ in (110.49 cm x 118.11 cm).


Bunnies Border

Sides: 2 – Side Borders $1\frac{1}{2}$ in x $43\frac{1}{2}$ in (3.81 cm x 110.49 cm); made in Step 10
 Top and Bottom: 2 – Top and Bottom Borders 2 in x $48\frac{1}{2}$ in (5.08 cm x 123.19 cm); made in Step 11
 Quilt Top - $46\frac{1}{2}$ in x $48\frac{1}{2}$ in (118.11 cm x 123.19 cm).

Shelves Border

Sides: 2 – Side Borders $4\frac{1}{2}$ in x $46\frac{1}{2}$ in (11.43 cm x 123.19 cm); made in Step 12
 Top and Bottom: 2 – Top and Bottom Borders $4\frac{1}{2}$ in x $56\frac{1}{2}$ in (11.43 cm x 143.51 cm); made in Step 13
 Quilt Top - $54\frac{1}{2}$ in x $56\frac{1}{2}$ in (138.43 cm x 143.51 cm).



Finishing

- Remove the selvages from the Wagoneer Backing fabric.
Note: Check orientation of designs. Cut one piece 41 $\frac{3}{4}$ in x 63 in (106.05 cm x 160.02 cm) and two pieces 21 $\frac{1}{4}$ in x 31 $\frac{3}{4}$ in (55.25 cm x 80.65 cm). Pin RST and sew the two smaller pieces on the short edges; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew along the long edges as shown in Diagram O. Press the seam open or to one side. The Backing should measure 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 63 in (158.75 cm x 160.02 cm).
- Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, **wrong** side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
- Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.



62 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 63 in (158.75 cm x 160.02 cm)

- Binding** – Follow Diagram P to make the Floral Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the six 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (6.35 cm) x wof strips RST end to end at a 45° angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in (5.08 cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.

Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. **Tip:** Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
