

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Banner Panel - Black (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 20 ½" x 42 ½" strip, centered on the panel.

From the Folio - Black (B), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 52 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 69 ½" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 60 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 36 ½" WOF strips.

From the Wheat Star Calico - Black (C), cut:

- (8) 3 %" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (75) 3 %" squares.
- (1) 2 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 2 %" squares.
- (2) 3" x 42 ½" x WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 20 ½" strips.

From the Folio - Off White (D), cut:

- (6) 2 \%" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (76) 2 \%" squares.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

From the Folio - Ochre (E), cut:

- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 1/8" squares.
- (1) 2 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 %" squares.

From the Small Novelty-Spring - Green (F), cut:

- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/8" squares and (2) 3 1/2" squares.
- (1) 2 \%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 \%" squares.

From the Pinwheel Ombre - Cream/Gold (G), cut:

- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 3 1/8" squares.
- (1) 2 \%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 \%" squares.

From the Wheat Star Calico - Green (H), cut:

- (1) 3 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 3 %" squares.
- (1) 2 \%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 \%" squares.

From the Folio - Christmas Green (I), cut:

- (1) 3 \%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 3 \%" squares.
- (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 2 1/8" squares.

From the Small Novelty-Winter - Red (J), cut:

- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 3 1/8" squares and (2) 3 1/2" squares.
- (1) 2 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 %" squares.

From the Wheat Star Calico - Red (K), cut:

- (4) 7" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams cut (2) 7" x 62 ½" strips.
- (3) 4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4" x 57 ½" strips.
- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 3 1/8" squares.
- (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (9) 2 1/8" squares.

From the Folio - Forest (L), cut:

- (1) 3 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 3 %" squares.
- (1) 2 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 %" squares.

From the Pinwheel Ombre - Red (M), cut:

- (1) 3 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 3 %" squares.
- (1) 2 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 2 %" squares.

From the Winding Vines - Rust (N), cut:

- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 1/8" squares.
- (1) 2 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 %" squares.

From the Small Novelty-Fall - Black (O), cut:

- (1) 3 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 3 %" squares and (2) 3 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 \%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 2 \%" squares.

From the Small Novelty-Summer - Dark Blue (P), cut:

- (1) 3 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/8" squares and (2) 3 1/2" squares.
- (1) 2 \%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 2 \%" squares.

Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Winding Vines - Blue (Q), cut:

• (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/8" squares.

From the Pinwheel Ombre - Green (R), cut:

- (1) 3 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 3 %" squares.
- (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/8" squares.

From the Folio - Spruce (S), cut:

- (1) 3 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 %" squares.
- (1) 2 \%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 2 \%" squares.

From the Folio - Gold (T), cut:

• (1) 2 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 2 %" squares and (4) 2" x 3" strips.


From the Pinwheel Ombre - Red (Backing), cut:

• (2) 86" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 74" x 86" back.


Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.


1. Sew (1) 3" x 42 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the 20 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 3" Fabric T strip to each end of (1) 2" x 20 ½" Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the 20 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 ½" x 44 ½" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).



2. Place (1) 2 1/8" Fabric D square on top of (1) 2 1/8" Fabric T square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 1/2" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.




3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 5-20 for fabric identification and placement to make the designated number of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " units for Unit 2 through Unit 17. There will be a total of (152) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.



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- 4. Follow Figure 21 and sew together (22) assorted 2 ½" blocks together to make the Pieced Border 1-Left Side Border.
- 5. Follow Figure 22 and sew together (22) assorted 2 ½" blocks together to make the Pieced Border 1-Right Side Border.

6. Follow Figure 23 and sew together (14) assorted 2 ½" blocks together to make the Pieced Border 1-Top Border.

7. Follow Figure 24 and sew together (14) assorted 2 ½" blocks together to make the Pieced Border 1-Bottom Border.

- 8. Follow Figure 25 and sew together (24) assorted 2 ½" blocks together to make the Pieced Border 2-Left Side Border.
- 9. Follow Figure 26 and sew together (24) assorted 2 ½" blocks together to make the Pieced Border 2-Right Side Border.



10. Follow Figure 27 below and sew together (16) assorted 2 ½" blocks together to make the Pieced Border 2-Top Border.


11. Follow Figure 28 below and sew together (16) assorted 2 ½" blocks together to make the Pieced Border 2-Bottom Border.

12. Place (1) 3 %" Fabric C square on top of (1) 3 %" Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 29). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 29). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 30) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3 ½" square to make (2) Unit 18 squares (Fig. 31). Repeat to make (20) Unit 18 squares total.









13. Repeat Step 12 and refer to Figures 32-44 for fabric identification and placement to make the designated number of 3 ½" units for Units 19 through Unit 31. There will be a total of (150) 3 1/2" squares. Note: Only (13) Unit 27 squares and (9) Unit 30 squares will be used.

14. Follow Figure 45 and sew together (18) assorted 3 ½" blocks to make the Pieced Border 3-Left Side Border.

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15. Follow Figure 46 and sew together (18) assorted 3 ½" blocks to make the Pieced Border 3-Right Side Border.

16. Follow Figure 47 below and sew together (12) assorted 3 ½" blocks. Sew (1) 3 ½" Fabric F square to the left end of the new strip and (1) 3 ½" Fabric P square to the right end to make the Pieced Border 3-Top Border.

17. Follow Figure 48 below and sew together (12) assorted 3 ½" blocks. Sew (1) 3 ½" Fabric J square to the left end of the new strip and (1) 3 ½" Fabric O square to the right end to make the Pieced Border 3-Bottom Border.

18. Follow Figure 49 and sew together (24) assorted 3 ½" blocks to make the Pieced Border 4-Left Side Border.

19. Follow Figure 50 and sew together (24) assorted 3 ½" blocks to make the Pieced Border 4-Right Side Border.

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- 20. Follow Figure 51 below and sew together (20) assorted 3 ½" blocks. Sew (1) 3 ½" Fabric F square to the left end of the new strip and (1) 3 ½" Fabric P square to the right end to make the Pieced Border 4-Top Border.
- 21. Follow Figure 52 below and sew together (20) assorted 3 ½" blocks. Sew (1) 3 ½" Fabric J square to the left end of the new strip and (1) 3 ½" Fabric O square to the right end to make the Pieced Border 3-Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
22. Sew the Side Pieced Border 1 strips to the Center Block.
Sew the Top and Bottom Pieced Border 1 strips to the
Center Block.

- 23. Sew the Side Pieced Border 2 strips to the Center Block. Sew the Top and Bottom Pieced Border 2 strips to the Center Block.
- 24. Sew 2 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 36 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 25. Sew the Side Pieced Border 3 strips to the Center Block. Sew the Top and Bottom Pieced Border 3 strips to the Center Block.


- 26. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 27. Sew (1) 7" x 62 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4" x 57 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 28. Sew (1) 2" x 69 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 60 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 29. Sew the Side Pieced Border 4 strips to the Center Block. Sew the Top and Bottom Pieced Border 4 strips to the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 30. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 31. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 32. Bind as desired.
